Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> @ 2:30: Pizza Social

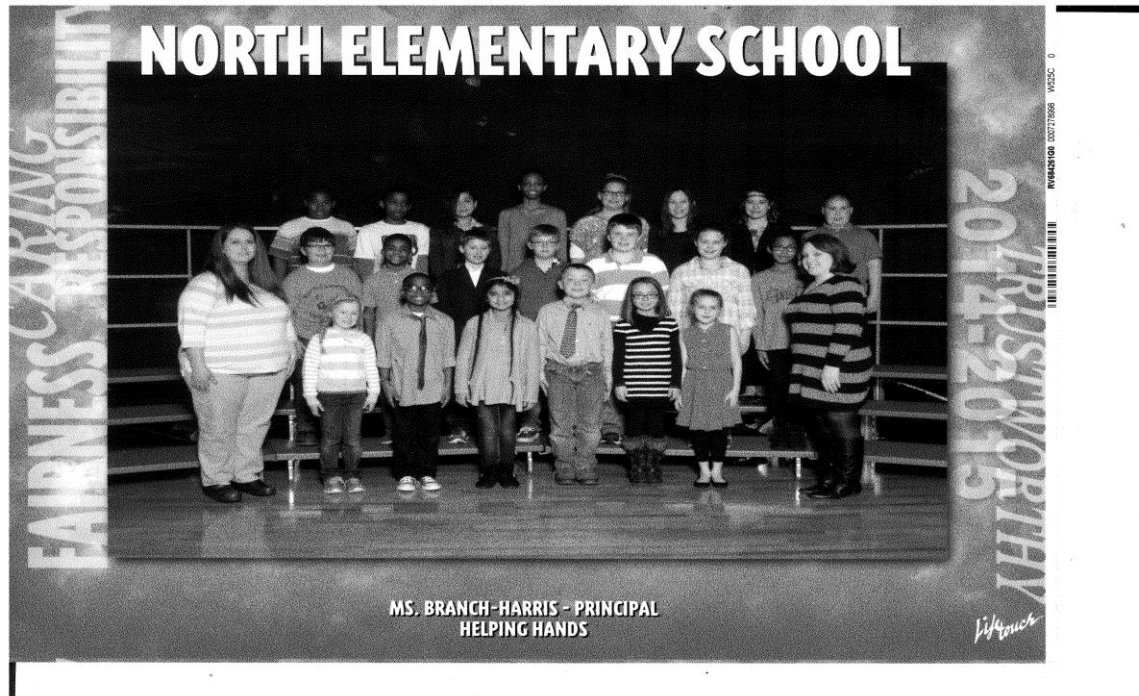
Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> @ 2:30: Country & Western Day with lots of games and cowboy snacks!
